## Rev. James Grossmann "God Sends the Firstfruits of His Spirit"

Acts 2:5-21

Theme: On Pentecost, Jesus Pours Out The Firstfruits of His Holy Spirit On His Disciples Reversing Some of the Enmity Because of Sin.

- I. You can See the Effects of the Wind, but You Cannot See the Wind vv. 1-4
  - A. The Disciples are Obedient to Christ and Stay in Jerusalem v. 1
