II Kings 19

Theme: God’s People Lay the Challenges and Dangers of this World at His Feet and He Cares for Them.

- I. Man Threatens, God and His People Laugh – vv. 1-21
 - A. God Comforts Hezekiah in Light of the Assyrian Threats – vv. 1-7
