“Perfection Through Jesus' Sacrifice”
Hebrews 10:1-18

Theme: Believers are Saved Perfectly through Christ's Final Sacrifice.

- I. OT Sacrifices are a Shadow of the Good Things to Come – vv. 1-4
 - A. The Law as a Shadow Cannot Bring Perfection – vv. 1-2; Heb 8:5; 7:19
 - B. The Sacrifices of the Law Cannot Take Away Sin – vv. 3-4; Le 16:12; Heb 10:11

- II. Christ's Sacrifice Sets Believers Apart – vv. 5-10
 - A. Sacrifice and Offering God Did Not Desire – vv. 5-7; Ge 3:15; Lk 24:44
 - B. Christ Came to do God's Will in Our Salvation – vv. 8-9; Is 1:11; Heb 5:8
 - C. Believers are Set Apart by the Sacrifice of Christ's Body – v. 10; Heb 13:12; 7:27

- III. Christ's Sacrifice Perfects Those Set Apart – vv. 11-18
 - A. Christ's Sacrifice Is Final – vv. 11-12; Ex 30:10; Heb 1:3
 - B. Christ is Reigning 'till His Enemies are All Made Subject to Him – vv. 13-14; I Co 15:25-28
 - C. Christ's Sacrifice Purchases Remission of Sins – vv. 15-18; 2 Co 3:3; Jer 31:34; Lk 24:47
